Nomination procedure	As soon as you have nominated your students, you can send us by e-mail their contact details (Name, email, duration of stay, level of studies) and we will send them all the necessary information.		
Nomination deadlines	15 May for the fall semester 1 November for the spring semester		
Application procedure	Students will be sent a link to connect and apply on our MoveOn platform. The following documents are required: - CV - Cover letter - Academic results - European Health Insurance Card - Copy of the passport or European national ID - Proof of enrollment in their home university for the academic year of the exchange (student card or certificate with the current academic year visible) - Learning Agreement completed and signed by the student and the academic coordinator from his home university

Those courses are granted 1 to 3 ECTS according to the level. In order to improve their French, students can also participate in the tandem program or conversation workshops.
